PARKING

Parking restrictions are as follows: No parking allowed Gunhouse St. - northerly (woods) side, Pond St. - westerly (high school) side, Massapoag Ave. - easterly (sidewalk) side, East St. - northerly (opposite sidewalk) side, Ames St. - southerly side, Quincy St. - either side, Cedar St. - either side, Beach St. - either side.

Parking is available at Deborah Sampson Park, Sharon High School, and Dr. Walter Griffin Playground. Limited parking for the handicapped is available on a "first come first served basis" until 8:15 p.m. and is available on Beach St. only. Entry is at Pond St. only. No one will be allowed to leave these spaces at the conclusion of the fireworks until the area is cleared of pedestrian traffic. There will be no parking in the Memorial Beach area due to safety concerns.

The public boat launching area will be closed. No boating is allowed on the lake for the entire day.

Parking ordinarily used by residents for the public beach will not be available.
